- 1829 George Fabes: Devonport - Montreal
- 1855 John: Diptford - Ontario
- 1873 Edward: Liverpool - Ontario

Manifest Destiny

1800's US belief, both obvious ("*manifest*") and certain ("*destiny*"), that the US was destined to expand westward across North America

Three tenets:

- The assumption of the unique moral virtue of the United States.
- The mission to redeem the world by the spread of republican government and more generally the "American way of life".
- Faith in the US's divinely ordained destiny to succeed in this mission.

Canada's Response

- 1864 Confederation Conferences
- 1867 Confederation happens
- Westward expansion - Emigration & Migration
- 1873 North-West Mounted Police
- 1875 Canadian Pacific RR reaches Winnipeg
- 1885 Completion of Transcontinental RR

- PEI - Dr. Samuel Willis 1931
- NL - George Robert Farrar 1946
- Devon - Ernest Albert Roger 1957

- 1912 Charles Chapman: Montreal – British Columbia
- 1928 Laurence Victor: Malborough - Saskatchewan

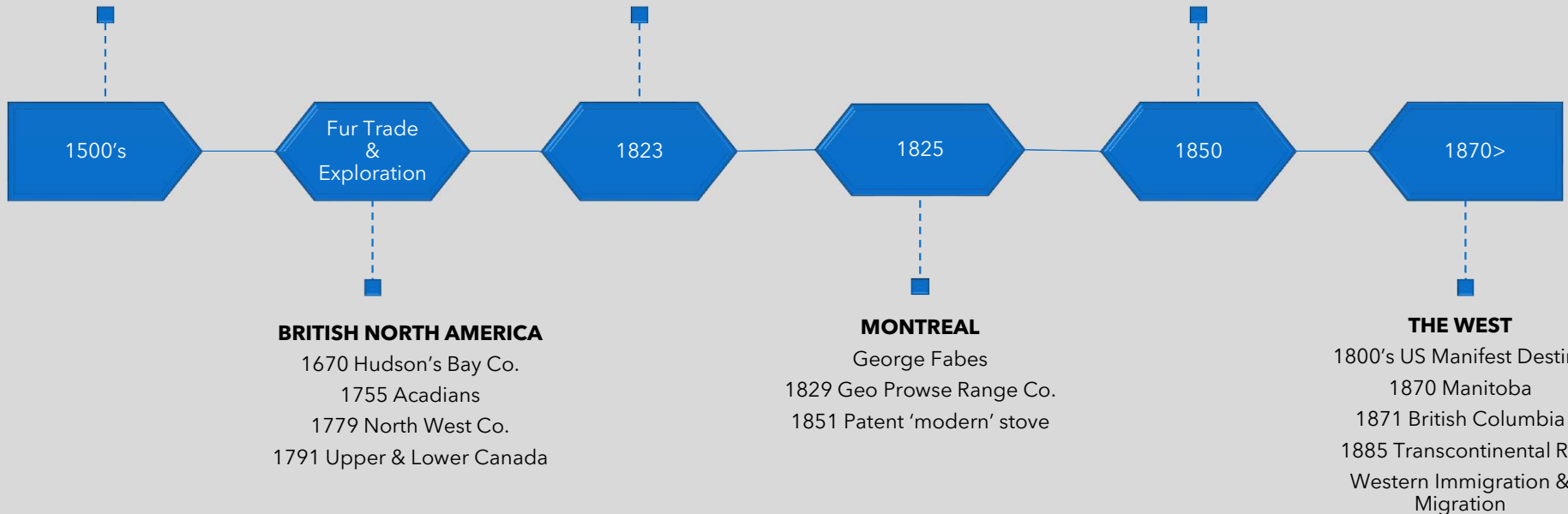
